Have a Student Aid Index (SAI) of \$30,000 or less for the academic year 2024-25

TO GET A MICHIGAN ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST

Enroll full-time at an eligible Michigan institution within 15 months of high school graduation or earning a high school equivalency certificate.

YOU WON'T KNOW IF YOU QUALIFY UNLESS YOU FILL OUT YOUR FAFSA!

FILLING OUT THE NEW FAFSA IS EASIER THAN EVER. Seriously.

- Filling out the FAFSA doesn't commit you to anything. It's simply the first step to evaluating your funding options.

4 STEPS FOR FILLING OUT FAFSA

Memorize your social security number (SSN)



2 CREATE YOUR FSA ID
YOU'LL NEED: Your social
security number & your
email address.

Ask your parents to create their own FSA ID



You should create a FSA ID three days before completing your FAFSA.
